<sup>4</sup>All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: <sup>5</sup>“Tell the daughter of Zion, ‘Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.’” *Matthew 21:4-5*

# GOD INVITES
